It's great to have you now my audience is very few of them are aware that I did some testing on my own reverse osmosis filtering water. I've talked about it on other platforms, my own aura water in my home and my own city tap water here in Dallas, Texas, we will go through some of those things that we discovered that are problematic, very majorly concerning. And then we can explain some of the symptoms that were created me and why it is so important that we filter crap out of water. And your products have helped many, many people continue to actually hear from them that they're seeing great success with their organic gardens and their gardens at home using your filtering product. So bring us up to speed on what you'd like to educate our audiences on today on the tension behind your products. Why it is you developed it again. We already did one show on that.

But why It's so important and crucial right now. What it is you can educate us on on what you've learned recently are most up to date information on what's in our water, why it's important to filter our water, even in our gardens and those things we're ingesting.

That's right. Well, since we talked last, there's been quite a few things, the ongoing challenge to protect ourselves and to get quality water, one of the big one of the big things that happened last year was the the difficulty discovery or announcement of poly floral alcohols, or PFA s, these are known as forever chemicals. And they're finding them all over the place. They're used in industry and manufacturing. They've been found in lakes and rivers, and certainly in tap water supplies. There's the the issue with these things as forever chemicals is there exactly that they don't break down much if at all over time. And there's really no precedent for these sorts of chemicals. And the issues that come up as a result from a health perspective or liver damage, you've got thyroid disease, decreased fertility, contributes to high cholesterol and obesity, hormone suppression, interestingly enough, and of course, cancer. So they've identified now over 9000 of these different chemicals. And just as of late, three months ago, the EPA announced that they were going to they were going to do a proposed maximum allowable amount of these in the tap water supplies. So that that equates to about four parts per trillion is what they say you don't want to go over, which is a very small amount of exposure. If you really think of it that way.

This idea of maximum allowable, I mean, ideally, maximum should be zero when you're talking about these sorts of things, and it should be taken very seriously, as regards exposure. And what about the other eight, almost 9000 They're only addressing six of these right now, the rest of everything, they're not even talking about that and just just a proposal, and in the meantime, the exposure goes on. So it's, it's something to be aware of, it's something to try to limit our exposure to and obviously the best way to do this is at the point of use, you know, you want to put it on the you know, your water supply at the house. If you've got water filtration there or if you bring in bottled water, you still got to be careful that but also specifically on your garden because what's going on your food is going into your food when you're when you're growing your own.

Absolutely. Well I'd like to ask Mike, what's going to be the benefits of adding this to our water in any amount? What's the health benefits to adding these two are tap water? Do you think these forever?

Well, there's certainly no benefits to it. I was just thinking as he was explaining that about I've just read about, you know, some of these larger corporations who are trying to settle out right now some some loss of huge lawsuits, you know, 10s of billions of dollars lawsuits that they're trying to settle out. Because they finally caught up with them with these type of forever pfas is what it is for the Forever chemicals. So is the acronym is pfas so if you look that up, you see it's pretty important stuff and pretty ugly stuff is what it is. And so,

So I'm gonna assume that your filters helped to get these chemicals out of your water, so it doesn't end up in your garden,

Our main filtration system is, is use a technology that's been around forever for many years, you know, carbon activated carbon block technology, and we've designed it for the garden use. So this you know, this is tried and proven technology for absorption of this type of chemicals. Volatile organic contaminants are known as VOCs. They add here to the carbon as it's flowing through the carbon filters. So we've designed our filtration systems with certain restrict flow restrictions in there that gives it more contact time. So the water has more contact time with the media, the carbon media and that allows it to eliminate or remove, reduce, remove, hopefully eliminate as much as possible this this type of chemicals.

Well, that is awesome. What are we excited to share with the world right now about your products? And what's new on the horizon?

Well, we've we've launched an additional website, you've been promoting the GrowMax Water Hydro Site, and we have GrowMaxWaterUSA.com. We've got lists of the VOCs that our systems eliminate and reduce. So it's very informative. We're excited to get people to check it out and get up to speed on what we So, we've got going.

That's awesome. I think last time we had you on the show we taught we actually showed how you could look up your own city water. And see what kind of chemicals are we are aware of are being traced or identified in those supplies all around the country. And I think that's something very helpful that everybody should look at. And we should showcase showcase that again, how easy that can be to identify look up. People just need to without knowing what's identified to be in your water already. And that is published. I think without even knowing that that's there. Most people have no idea that the water they're actually consuming bathing in or using in their gardens actually have a lot of chemicals, like we mentioned here with these forever, chemicals, PFA s chemicals. mean the EPA, I remember 1520 years ago, I was looking at statistics, where there's three to 5000 chemicals that had had been researched, studied to determine what their toxic effects what their poison effects were. But there was over 15,000 that hadn't even gotten to yet. So they were creating companies were manufacturing chemicals we were being exposed to in the environment faster than our government agencies were able to, to actually test and

qualify whether or not these things were toxic, deadly or harmful. So this is not something that is new. I guarantee you there's way more of these PFAS 's that have not been evaluated, tested or confirmed.

if I remember correctly, on the last one, we were here last week, I'd given you the link to there and you had put in your personal zip code. And you came up with you were kind of shocked, of course, that were some names of some chemicals that were you know those unpronounceable names that you know, methyl methyl in some kind of different pronunciations that were just looked like they were just ugly, ugly type of chemicals in there.

D Dr. Bryan Ardis 11:52

Right so I'm just gonna go in and share with the audience is a test report. I did this kind of beforehand, but this is actually a report that is on my Plano city tap water here. Outside of what you can look up online, I took the sample of a tap water and hand delivered reverse osmosis filtered water to my to my actual clinic in Ohio, and I wanted to know what's in it that's actually making me sick or possibly making me sick. And so the Plano city water I just want to share with you all what populated in my water sample I took there. This is if I don't have it filtered and I'm showering and bathing in it, cooking with it, using it on our flowers outside and our plants outside.

Alright, so this is what they found. We found pesticides and herbicides were in our water weaponized pathogens of flukes which are water based parasites. We found bromine, which is a horrific chemical use as a retardant and found in flame retardants but Vizia Panthera which is cool. It's actually a pathogen linked to limes disease. This was incredible to me. We found nano technology called black goo was identified in our Plano city tap water here in Texas.

Then we found vaccine signatures, not a joke, vaccine signatures of typhoid vaccines in our water, and also we found Hepatitis A signature in the water. We found weaponized squid venom, squid venom, yeah, Venom, squid venom. We found alkyl phenols BPA, which is another word for that. And then we found venom from the Uruguayan coral snake called phospho lipase ETU, which happens to be the exact enzyme that identified is in COVID patients leading to death. It's an enzyme found in snake venom.

I don't know how many Uruguay and coral snakes are swimming around in the Plano city water treatment facility, but their venom is showing up in their water. This Uruguayan coral snake venom, by the way was found in every single COVID-19 patient, blood and feces in Italy in

every city in Italy in June of 2020. Uruguayan coral snake and I used to make fun of this I used to say two years ago, what did everybody in Italy take a trip to Uruguay and I'll get bit by the same snake and then went back to Italy develop symptoms of respiratory failure, fevers and chills were diagnosed with COVID when they were PCR tested, it's pretty ridiculous. Then they found Korean we found Korean slim OSA snake venom from Korea in the venom in the water of Plano city water. And then we found multiwalled carbon nanotubes these are the nanotech this found in our Plano city water. nanotech machines was identified and super oxide was found in our water. These are just some of the things that were populated as physical entities inside the Plano city water. pretty disgusting. This is why we encourage everybody to have filtering systems for your wonder systems.

That is wild. Yeah. Wow. Wow. This website that your listeners can go to is called ewg.org. Forward slash tap water. And this is a database that's been created by EWG have over 31 million State Water Records. And they've been doing this since 2013. So I can even I can even share my screen and just I'll pop in your zip code just please do here. And we'll see what's going on with your water at least from their perspective and what they've searched. So here it is, here's their top water update. Breaking March this is just a few months ago when I was just talking about the EPA recently proposed new limits to tackle drinking water contamination from the toxic forever chemicals known as PFA s. Limits. The limits known as maximum contaminant levels are the highest level of contaminant allowed in drinking water the MCL is announced are four parts per trillion or PPT of PFOA and four parts per trillion PFOS. For the other four PFA s agency is proposing using a hazard index, which is a tool used to address the cumulative risks from mixtures of chemicals. The soup that comes out of your spigot, there you go.

So I popped in your you your zip code featured water city of Plano. So view utility, cell contaminants detected 19 exceed EWG health guidelines. And so if you scroll down, here you go. There's your arsenic. Here's your interesting 37 times what you would think should be there. Actually, yeah, what we allowed, I mean, ultimately would be zero bromate bromo core lactic acid,

Atrazine is horribly toxic, by the way.

Yes, yes, exactly. potential effect harm to the developing fetus, it gives you the actual what's the problem with this, this chemical just underneath the name. So lots of these harm to the thyroid. thyroid issues are all over the place nowadays, cancers affect cancer. So anyway, it's it's just, it's just wild. And when you see stuff like that, it's obviously really sobering. And it just,

it just drives home the the reality that we've got to take this into our own hands and, and make sure that at the point of use is where we're addressing this because we can't control it upstream, we can only control it where it hits our house.

Is it shocking to know that there's that many chemicals allowed to be put in our tap water? I think it's amazing. And then what do you think are the benefits to adding arsenic to your organic gardens, if you're not filtering your water you to what's the benefits of adding arsenic to your garden soil, if you've got arsenic in 37 times the the recommended limits in your tap water?

Well, you know, as we've talked about, too, you know, on our website, you can see that fruits and vegetables are basically 80 to 95% water. So it's pretty clear when you realize you know, your your strawberries are 92% Water, your tomatoes or 94%, water, cucumber 96% water, it's pretty clear that what you're putting onto your garden is coming out is ending up inside of the fruits and vegetables that you're growing.

So it just this is how we got started with GrowMax Water USA, I had been in water treatment for for 25 years before that treating homes, restaurants, hotels, light industry and this type and finally got together with longtime friend Matt Haines, who's been an organic gardener and health and wellness practitioner in general for for many years. And he started talking about the issues he was having with with the quality of the water that was being put that he was using in his garden. An incident had happened in one of the nearby cities where there was some copper being dumped in were here in Utah, and there's copper mines in our area. And so there was an issue with copper being dumped into the water supply and it was kind of an emergency they had talked about you need to boil your water. Right? Exactly right. So here's here's GrowMaxWaterUSA.com it just shows the definitely The benefits I've been using the Supergirl 100 unit that we have is it's a phenomenal piece. It's, it's perfect for just about any size backyard garden. And I have actually seen these results significantly over the last four years that I've been using it stronger roots, healthier vegetables, more drought tolerant vegetables, and fruit and bigger yields, bigger harvests. So it's it water definitely makes a difference. So, you know, there's a lot of if, if, if your neighbor is using pesticides, or if there's pesticides that are if you're in an agricultural area, our systems are designed to remove and reduce those out of your garden water supplies.

Well, listed on that list were in my city water we just looked at.

Oh, there you go. Right back. So we've also got more facts about chlorine and pesticides here. And then we've got our systems, it's real simple. We've made these things super easy to use. It's hose in hose out, we've got three different sizes, this small ones, the echo girl was really more for, call it indoor use. If you're doing indoor gardening, like using a tower garden, we actually just got one of these tower gardens in the fall. And they're really cool. It's only about a two foot square radius. But we grew vegetables, kale, chard, herbs, all three different kinds of lettuces, and we had them from the end of October all the way to March. So all through the

winter here in Utah, we had fresh vegetables right there. And it was just a super cool way to do it. Using the second row, this is the Super Bowl unit that I'm using right now that works phenomenal comes with a state that you can move this thing around the yard, anywhere you need it, it's a hose in hose out and boom, you're done and you're watering. So that's that's the that's the main bulk of it. We've got this. It's called a clean green carbon block filter, as we've labeled it in the way that it functions. The zero wastewater is another nice component, especially if you're in more drought, drought, drought amendable areas that it's zero wastewater, there's no there's nothing, there's nothing extra that has to be taken out of the water. It's just a quick, there's no, there's no slow flow within you this so that is that is it right there.

But America out loud.com Looking for healing radio. I did the entire show. I recorded it yesterday. Do you wanna know what the topic was? Medscape this week, announced medical journals have announced new research populated that over the next before the year 2050. They expect 1.3 1 billion human beings on the earth to be diagnosed diabetics 1.3 1 billion. I haven't done the math yet. But somebody can do the math, there's about a billion of us divide that by the divide 1.3 1 billion by eight. That'll tell you exactly what the percentage is. Okay, they are publishing this week that they know 1.3 billion people on this planet will be diabetics in the next 27 years. Double and a half what the current diabetic rate is, and then I just happened to

look it up and see Do they know if pesticides which are in our water? Are pesticides implicated in directly causing diabetes, and oh my god, they now he's just published it two months ago, I didn't even know this. But as I'm listening to you, I was like, I wonder what they know about this. Everything they are keeping track of and they know what they are orchestrating. And they are utilizing water systems to actually create the illnesses and diseases and the outcomes that they are doing, including pandemics. And if you don't know about that, look up the document from 2006 everybody at home called water and terrorism.
